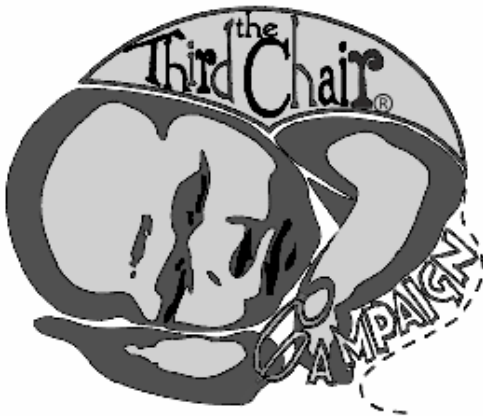

OUR MISSION

St. Bernard's Central Catholic High School, being dedicated to life from conception to natural death, has committed itself to advocating for the unborn through The Third Chair® Campaign.

It is the hope and desire of this academic institution to promote life through education, pro-life awareness, and advocacy in order to inspire the heart and conscience to the mission of the value of life through The Third Chair® Campaign.

THE COVERLETS

The coverlets are made for the purpose of inspiring the thoughts about the child who would have sat in the chair on which the coverlet is placed.

The coverlet is made to fit any standard sized classroom chair. It is a black felt material that drapes over the back of the chair with the words "I Might Have Been..." silk-screened on the front with a blank space for the possibilities "your prom date, your best friend, your team captain, an inspiration, a hero, etc" that you can fill in yourself. There are endless possibilities of what those aborted could have been. At the bottom of the coverlet there is a small pair

of precious baby feet printed on the material and continues with the words "Pray for the Unborn."

SOURCE OF INSPIRATION

In January of 2004 a group of students at St. Bernard's attended the Respect Life March in Washington, D.C. As a result of that experience, students decided to raise money to commission the making of a granite memorial dedicated to the unborn to be placed in the school's front lobby entrance.

The beginning of The Third Chair® Campaign came as a result of the schools dedication of that memorial to the unborn on May 5, 2004. The local Knights of Columbus served as honor guard, while the school's Campus Ministry members along with our bishop participated in a ceremony to bless the monument.

While working on the dedication ceremony, Campus Ministry Club members focused on the statistic of one in three babies being lost to abortion every day. Every third chair in the auditorium featured a card attached to the back of the chair with the words "I Might Have Been . . . your best friend, a devoted father, a doctor, etc." Statistically the students discovered that one-hundred and seventy two students could have potentially walked the halls of this academic institution. Shortly after this experience, it was decided to place a coverlet in each classroom to permanently remind

students in class of the young person who might have occupied the seat.

THE CAMPAIGN

St. Bernard's students, committed to the abolition of abortion, have committed themselves to The Third Chair® Campaign mission. Everything from the creation of brochures, the web site, the coverlets, and educational material are created by the students under adult supervision.
